## **STUDENT AWARDS**

### ***Puneet “Ashu” Ailawadi Memorial Award***

This award honors Dr. Puneet “Ashu” Ailawadi, a 2000 graduate of the University of Michigan Medical School who was completing a residency in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Michigan Health System at the time of his death. Dr. Ailawadi’s family, friends, and colleagues have established a memorial fund to honor him. In keeping with Dr. Ailawadi’s dedication to helping underserved communities, this award is presented annually to a senior medical student who has demonstrated a commitment to serving underprivileged and underserved populations.

This award is presented every year to a senior who best exemplifies these attributes. ***Wiegenstein Leadership in Emergency Medicine Award***

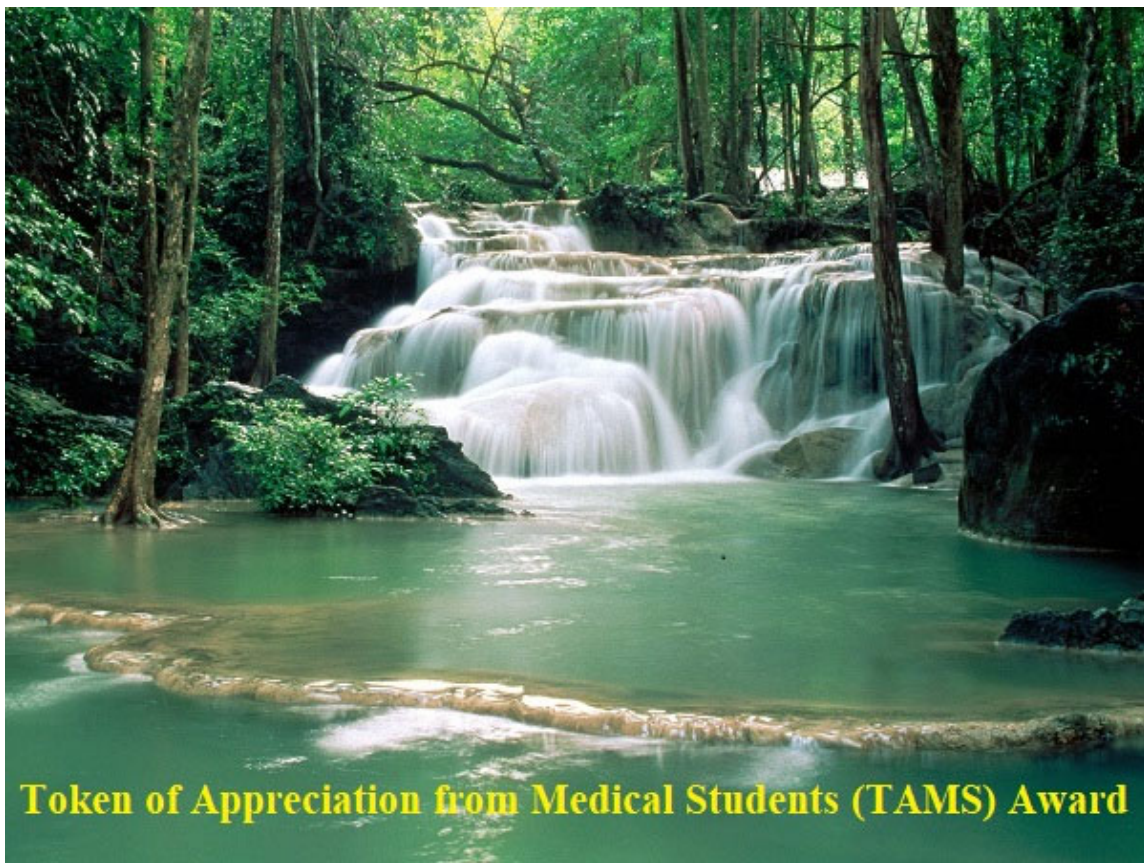
