The template for the IM Structured Evaluative Letter (IM SEL) has no changes in recommended guideline. The Fellowship Letter of Recommendations (LoR) Guidelines have improved the educational handover from residency to fellowship, improving reliability, equity, and efficiency through standardization. The Alliance reviewed and revised its Guidance for Fellowship Application Season and recommends that fellowship programs conduct virtual interviews for all applicants, including learners at their own institutions. In the fall of 2022, AAIM released recommendations on how to integrate equity and inclusion into residency interview process, which can be readily adapted for the fellowship interview process.

A separate written letter of recommendation is not necessary if utilizing the eSLOR. After sending the ERAS request form to your author(s), visit the eSLOR Applicant page on the AOA website. You must first sign an agreement and enter your ERAS AAMC ID and Letter IDs before letter author(s) can begin an eSLOR.
